Scholarship Guidelines

PCCA will be offering ¼ and ½ scholarships / tuition discounts for the 2017/2018 school year.

The following guidelines are to be followed when approving disbursement of scholarship dollars:

1. Student application and enrollment packet must be completed.
2. Student must complete scholarship application.
3. Students will be allowed a maximum of 1/2 cost of full year tuition unless person(s) providing scholarship have other guidelines, restrictions, or provisions.
4. Scholarships may be available primarily for low income families (using modified federal and state poverty guidelines) & will require proof of income (US-1040) ***SEE ATTACHED GUIDELINES***
5. Scholarships may also be available for single parent homes, multiple children, or certain family situation (death of parent, loss of job, etc.)
6. Scholarships are to be awarded upon recommendation of the PCCA Scholarship Committee and approval of the PCCA board.
7. Scholarships are to be paid directly to PCCA on the behalf of eligible student and not to the student receiving the scholarship.
8. Student must maintain a clean discipline record –
 - a. Level II – loss of scholarship for that month
 - b. Level III – loss of scholarship for 3 months
9. Student must maintain a passing grade in all subjects.
 - a. D/F slips to be sent out – loss of scholarship until student is eligible w/ D or higher grade level
10. Student's family must volunteer a minimum of 3 hours a month for each ½ scholarship (\$2160).
 - a. If these hours are not completed (allowed to complete w/in 2 months of the month required) there will be a charge of \$60.00 per hour not served.
 - b. If volunteer hours are not completed or penalty paid – student will not receive transcript or be passed to the next grade level.
11. If you receive any type of scholarship, you will not be eligible for any additional tuition discount.
12. Scholarships will begin being awarded after June 15th based on available scholarship funds.

Each student's case will be assessed by the scholarship committee and PCCA board of directors. Guidelines are subject to change according to the need of the student. These guidelines are for scholarships that are funded through general funds, private donation and undesignated scholarship funds. Additional guidelines for other funding sources may be provided with the particular scholarship.
